Fiscal Officer Steele read the January 2020 Fiscal Report. On Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>, there was an overall Fund Balance of \$5,375,596.70 there was \$304,424.98 in Revenue and \$364,174.99 in Expenditures leaving an overall Fund Balance on January 31<sup>st</sup> of \$5,315,726.95.

Fiscal Officer Steele explained that there were post audit adjustments in late 2019, that added monies into the Bond Fund that was used for construction at 3820 Cleveland Ave. Before closing the 2019 books Amending the 2019 Permanent Appropriations allowed the FO to reallocate construction expenses to come out of Bond Fund instead of the General Fund.

Fire Chief Brian Fraley update everyone that there are no current known cases of <u>Coronavirus 19</u> in the area. He suggested folks keep areas clean, as is normally encouraged during flu season. Police and the Sherriff's office are receiving daily bulletins.

The produce market recently feed 85 families, and there will be a Community Health Action Team meeting tomorrow night at 6pm, at 3820 Cleveland Ave.

Police Chief Jones updated everyone that his Department is partnering more with NetCare for mental health resources, such as when there is a death of a child in a home family members need direct and specialized care to cope with that trauma.

Ms. Olt added she is upset for loss of an excellent employee and she would like to know why Mr. Vaughn no longer works for the Township. Trustee Sword responded that the Board does not publicly discuss issues around personnel.

Resident Carol Stuart requested shade grass to be planted behind the garden plot on Chambers Cir

Resident Donna Goodman Adassa asked when brush chipping will start. Superintendent Fleig responded mid-April.
