On Jan 1st the Township had an overall balance of \$9,048,656.45. There was \$346,841.89 in Revenue and \$507,596.68 in Expenses leaving a balance of \$8,898,520.61 on Feb 28th.

Fiscal Officer Steele said the Board had a draft to Amend the 2023 Permanent Appropriations and suggested waiting until the Road resurfacing discussion later in the meeting to revise the draft.

COMMITTEE/TEAM REPORTS

A Free Produce Market update was provided by Chief Fraley of the Community Health Action Team. March 10, 2023, with 11,000 pounds of food distributed to 453 individuals. The next Produce Market is March 24, 2023, from 4:00 – 6:00pm.

Trustee Grimm said she would soon provide meeting minutes from the recent Budget Committee meeting.

Trustee Cera reminded everyone of the importance of completing FormFire before the end of the month.

ADMINISTRATION

Administrator Huffman discussed with the Board revising the 3-day elective training language, and credit card limits in the Employee Handbook. Mr. Huffman also reported that so far 2 surveys are for a westside LED sign and 2 are against the idea. A total of 12 homes were sent a survey. The University View Civic Association would like to post their upcoming events.

POLICE

The Axon Body Cam agreement is coming up for renewal soon. Also, the County Sheriff recently increased the dispatch call fee. Chief Jones estimates the Township is saving \$30K a year with the substation agreement. Trustee Cera asked for more details, Chief Jones responded that the first 160 calls per month are of no cost so the agreement keeps up with the increase in per call costs.

PUBLIC WORKS

Superintendent Medley updated everyone that the Board will know in May if the application for the Small Government Grant was accepted, he expected the project could start around June 2024. Trustee Cera suggested being ready to apply for the next cycle if this one is not approved.

There was a discussion around a recent Roads resurfacing proposal. Mr. Medley has divided the Township into 7 areas. An estimate of just under \$500K to treat many roads north of Ferris is being considered. He said he would move forward with at least \$300K of the proposal. The Board was recently advised that JEDZ could support this resurfacing proposal. Trustee Cera reviewed recent years Public Works carryover monies, and that the first two months of this current year only needed \$70K to cover their expenses. Fiscal Officer Steele said there is room to Appropriate up to an additional \$50K in the Road and Bridge Fund. Trustee Cera said she would like to discuss a JEDZ investments more with the Board, but she is sure she would like to see the Road and Bridge Fund cover some of this resurfacing project, whatever amount is chosen to move forward with. She further added if the Public Works Department ends up needing a transfer she will support it, but she does not see such a need at this time. FO Steele suggested having \$330K covered by CEDA in the General Fund, \$120K covered by JEDZ in the General Fund, and \$50K covered by the Road and Bridge Fund.

Resident Will Dobbs has had continued issues with 1874 Sale Rd dumping garbage in the street that attacks rats. Trustee Jessberger recalls ongoing issues with this address.
